

As a gesture of encouragement, **notebooks and pencils were distributed** to all the participating children, symbolising a fresh and blessed start to their learning journey.





In a spirit of collaboration, the HOTA Forum also offered its full support and assistance to the Department in planning and executing future Hindu cultural and religious events.






# BAPS Swaminarayan Mandir, Kemps Creek Inauguration




# **Embrace Equality - JET Australia Foundation**


