<u>Starting with NSW</u>: - Though the year started with some freedom eventually got us to lockdown, but none of our events or activities stopped.

Spiritual start seeking the blessing of the Bhagawan Hayagriva, VHP Walk was initiated to bring together all
the VHP Branches families and friends for a healthy funwalk by HYA., The International Yoga Day, Vaccination
awareness programs, more assistance in terms of grocery purchase, rent payment, etc are being provided
to the needy families, VHP also conducted Ganesh Chaturthi contest.

VHP Australia has more than 255 teachers, teaching in 80 schools in various suburbs, who volunteertheir time every week to prepare and teach children about their Hindu dharma.

- Green party Vs VHP Australia- A Perfect example of Dharma winning over Adharma, and thestrength of our unity, special HOTA meeting was held on 28th March addressing the allegations made by Mr. David Shoebridge. Prepared a joint resolution letter to NSW Multicultural Minister which was signed by 40 + organizations. This joint resolution letter enabled the matter being taken up in the NSW parliament on 12th May 2021 to overrule the allegations made by Mr. David Shoebridge. The motion was unanimously passed by the speaker following joint representation from the members of Liberal, Labor and One Nation parties.
- LALITHA SAHASRANAAMA LAKSHAARCHANA, Vishnu Sahasra Naamaavali & Lakshmi Ashtottra Archana by VCCA. VCCA is also organising online group chanting for ever Pradhosam, Shasti and Pournami and conducting Veda classes and Adult Pravesha and Vishnu Sahasranaamam classes.

- VCCA purchased a land in Marsden Park (North West suburb) for building a Community Centre. An
 Architect has been hired to prepare plans for submission to Council.
- Exploring Hinduism for Teens and Parents By Hindu University of America teamed up with VHP,10weeks with 2 online session per week, lot of our volunteers and Hindu Dharma teachers are participating.
- Annual HOTA Forum was hosted by ISKCON in May which was attended by 55 representatives from Temples, Organizations and Associations. The chief guests were Hon Kevin Conolly, state MP for Riverstone and Ms. Durga Owen, representing Hon Julie Owens Federal Labor MP for Parramatta.

SRE- Hindu Dharma & VHP Volunteers

Any changes or updates will be emailed to all our volunteers, till then the existing Public Health Order requiring mandatory vaccination for education and care workers, any work undertaken at a government school or non-government school (this includes work by teachers, support staff, corporate employees, contractors, volunteers and students on student placement)

Every one of is encouraged to have your Vaccination proof handy, you will need to attest that you are fully vaccinated against COVID-19. You will then be asked by a responsible person (such as the principal) to show evidence of vaccination.

Evidence of vaccination includes:

Fully vaccinated:


- an online immunisation history statement External link or
- > a COVID-19 digital certificate from the Australian Immunisation Register External link.

Medical contraindication:

a medical contraindication certificate from a medical practitioner in a form approved by the Chief Medical Officer External link, that specifies the medical contraindication.

You may not be allowed onto a school without showing evidence of fully vaccinated against COVID-19.

We encourage all those eligible over 5 to talk to your GP and get Vaccinated.
